



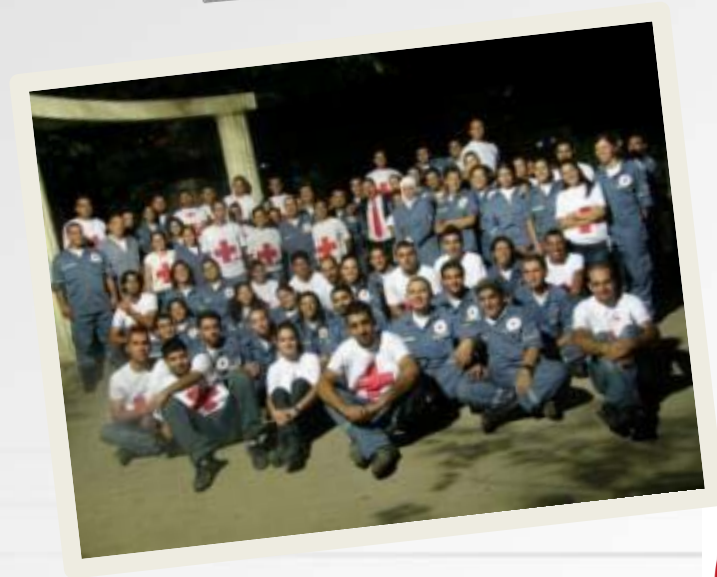
Lebanese Red Cross – Youth Department

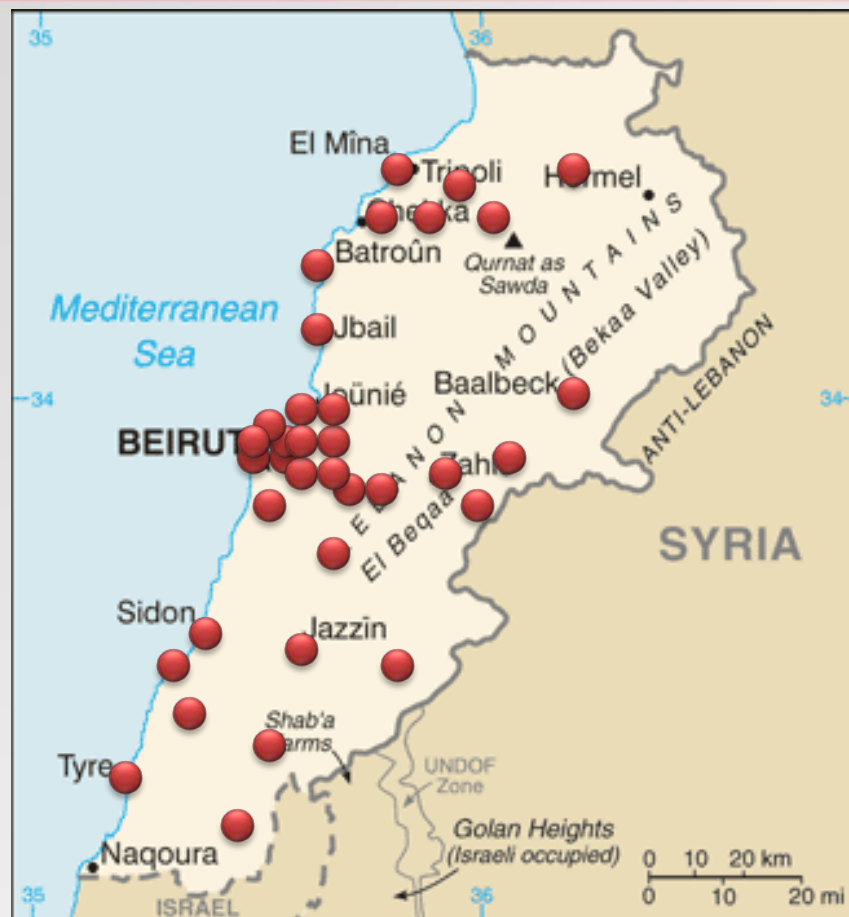

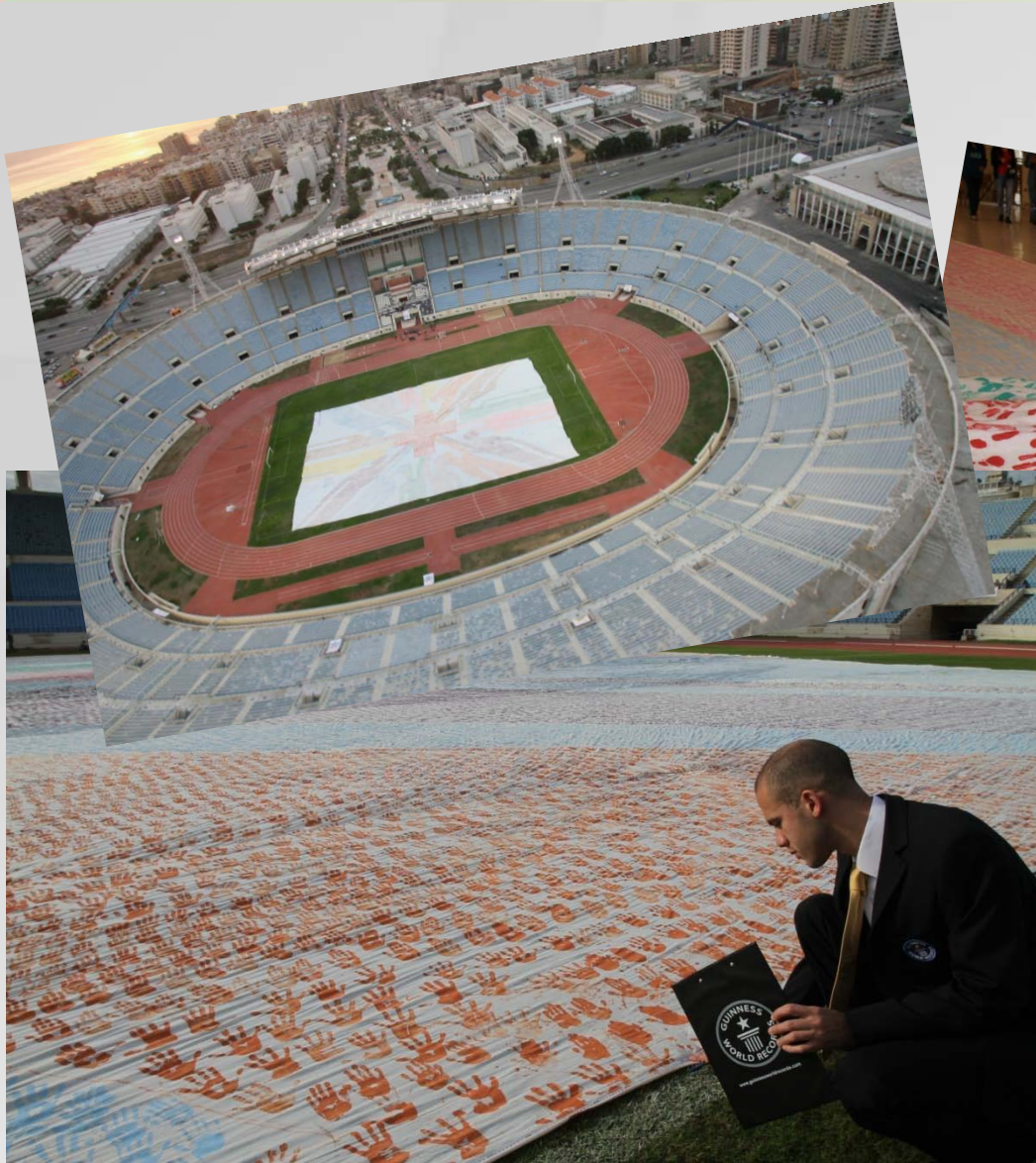
