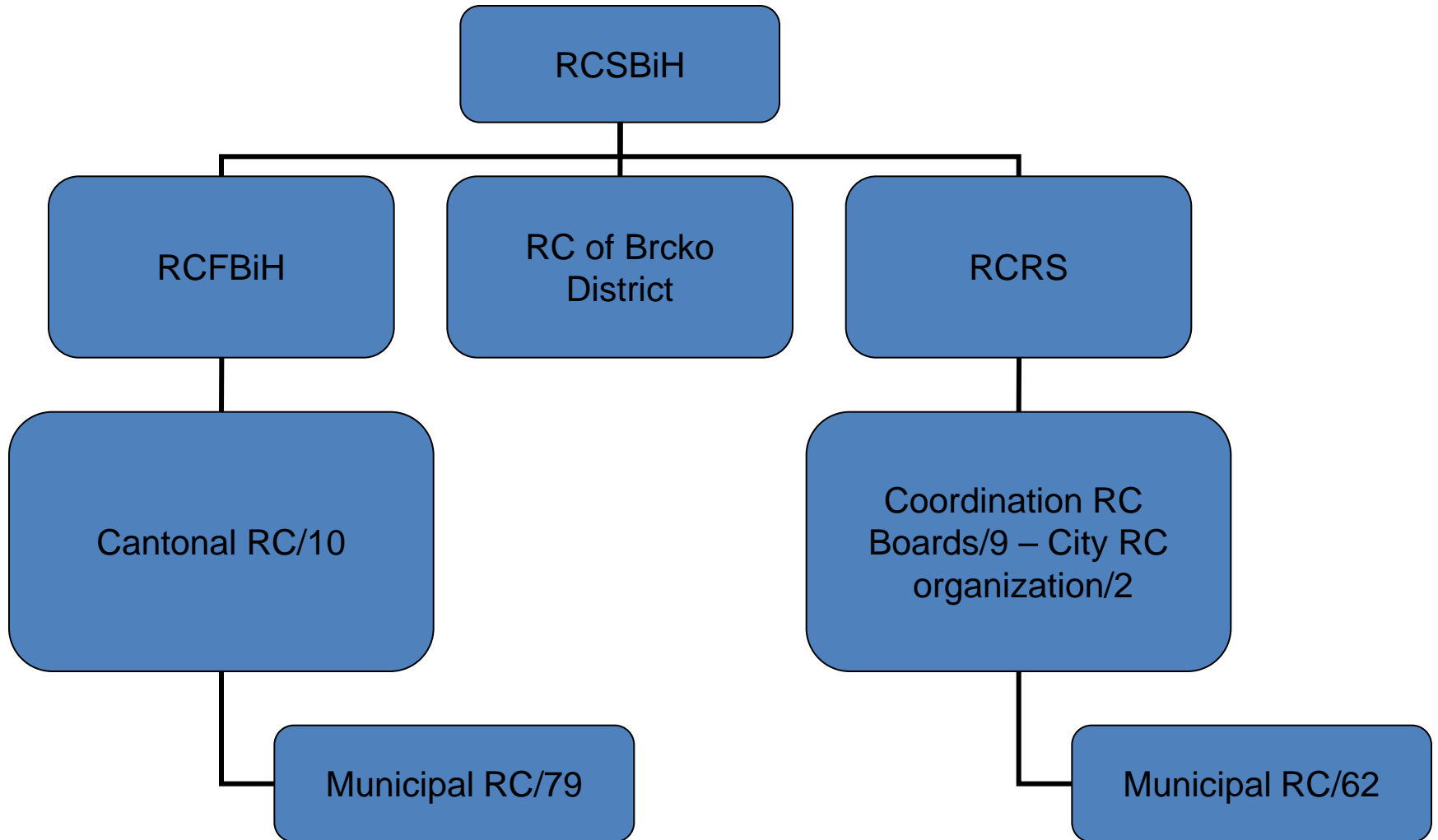
The Red Cross Society of Bosnia and Herzegovina strives to:
