Informing the public...



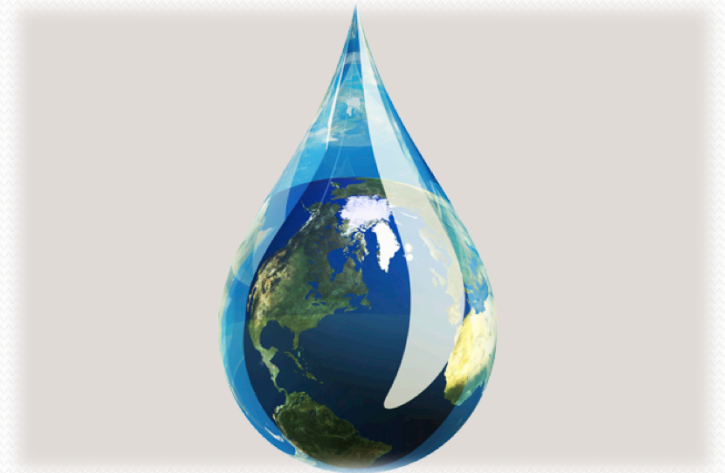
- Distribution of informative brochures
